- the enemy of our soul










I must meet <u>certain standards</u> to feel good about myself


Sapphira

AGGRESSOR

- Keeps herself too busy for deep relationships



Therefore...


Because of **CHRIST** I have been made brand new, complete in Christ. I no longer need to experience the pain of shame.










Cooperate with the ultimate Makeover Artist
