Feedback acknowledges the choice, but provides additional content as to why it was good, ok, or not so good. **Best Choice** Acceptable Choice Poor Choice Leads to try another. Scenario of setting where skill is to be used different from opener and first scenario. Learner is the coach for the character to help the character decide what to do. SCENARIO 2 What do you do now question with three choices: good, ok and poor. Acknowledge choices, provide feedback, and additional explainer content. **Best Choice** Acceptable Choice Poor Choice Transition to review. Review repeats key points. If quiz is needed, focus on key points, or another scenario. Review Optional Quiz
